## Non-Infrastructure Efforts in 2015 Bike Plan Update

The following lists recommendations of the 2015 Bike Plan Update which are ongoing or completed.

- Promote the Miami Valley Trails – the nation’s largest paved trail network
  - Published the Miami Valley Bikeways map every three years since 2005
  - Continue operation and maintenance of Miami Valley Trails web site
  - Facilitate consensus among Miami Valley Trail managing agencies regarding e-bike use on the network
- Promote Bike Pooling through MVRPC’s Rideshare Program
- Partner with Bike Miami Valley on educational and safety initiatives
- Lights on Bikes programs
- Increase the number of Bike Friendly Communities in the region
- Encourage more communities to adopt local complete streets policies
- Continue to sponsor Bike to Work Day and Bike Month events
- Continue to sponsor and support the Miami Valley Cycling Summit
- Compile partner agency trail counter data and develop on-street bike counting program
- Conduct trail user surveys (every four years since 2009)
- Maintain mapped inventory of local bicycle facilities that complement the regional trails network
